## ***ANZTCA Contestable Scholarship Funds Application Criteria***

At the 2008 AGM three Contestable Scholarship Funds were created for the benefit of ANZTCA members. These three funds are:

- ***ANZTCA Conference Fund*** (registration &/or travel costs for annual NZ conference)
- ***Resources & Training Fund*** (registration, enrolment, course related &/or travel costs for training events, courses, etc other than for ANZTCA & IACHE conferences)
- ***IACHE Conference Fund*** (registration &/or travel costs for 4 yearly global conference)

### **Application Criteria:**

1. Applicant's Name.
2. Tertiary Education Institute (university, polytechnic,...).
3. Full-time/part-time status.
4. A budget for the Conference or Resource & Training event/item, including a clear indication of:
  - a. Funding available from other sources
  - b. The amount requested from the Contestable Fund.
5. The professional &/or personal outcomes expected from attending the Conference or Resource & Training event, etc.
6. A commitment to the Association for at least **1 year** from the date of the Conference or Resource & Training event, etc.
7. Current membership status:
  - a. Fees paid
  - b. Code of Ethical Practice signed.

## Application Process:

Applications can be emailed to ANZTCA Secretary/Treasurer Mike Wright at [chaplain@op.ac.nz](mailto:chaplain@op.ac.nz) including full details (see *criteria above*), to arrive no later than the relevant closing date(s) – see *below*.

All applications will be prayerfully considered by the ANZTCA Executive.

It is the goal of the Executive to inform applicants of the outcome within **10 working days** of the relevant closing date.

### Closing dates for applications:

ANZTCA Conference Fund      **31 July** annually

Resources & Training Fund      **June 30** and **November 30** annually

IACHE Conference Fund      **November 30** of year preceding the IACHE Conference.
